

# MoDOT Worker Raising Money For Fallen Workers Memorial

Missouri Department of Transportation Maintenance Worker Kris Sandgren, an avid bicyclist from Springfield, MO, will spend three weeks of his vacation this summer to pedal across country raising money for MoDOT's Fallen Workers Memorial.

Since 1946, 128 MoDOT employees have died in the line of duty. Sandgren is one of MoDOT's 6,000 workers who are seeking donations on their own time to pay for a memorial honoring the 128.

Sandgren plans to ride 2,500 miles from Anacortes, WA, to Jefferson City, MO, starting June 21. His hope is for people to contribute 1 cent a mile. Each

\$25 gift will go toward the estimated **\$94,000** cost of the memorial to be built on the State Capitol grounds in Jefferson City.

The memorial cannot be built until all the money is in hand. Many dollars are still needed.

Please help Kris Sandgren and all MoDOT employees honor those Missouri state highway workers who made the ultimate sacrifice.
